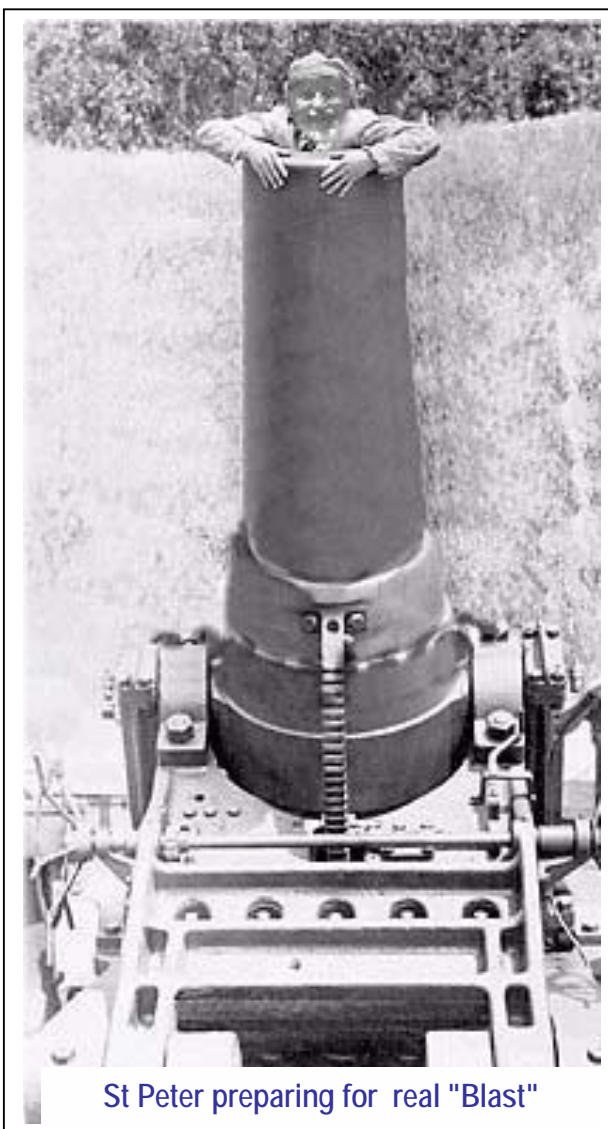




## OLD GUYS TAKE CONTROL & FIRE THE FIRST SHOT

Don't forget this important event. This is a great chance to get a group of your friends together, put those party clothes on and have a fantastic time, so **DON'T MISS OUT**.

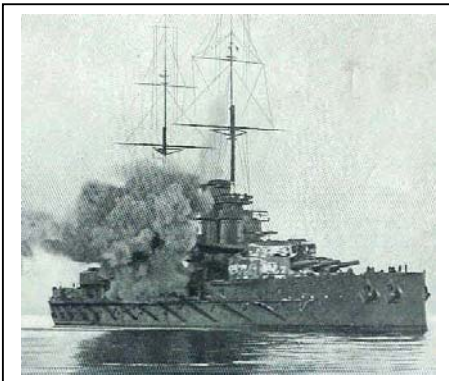

### Tip for the Coach

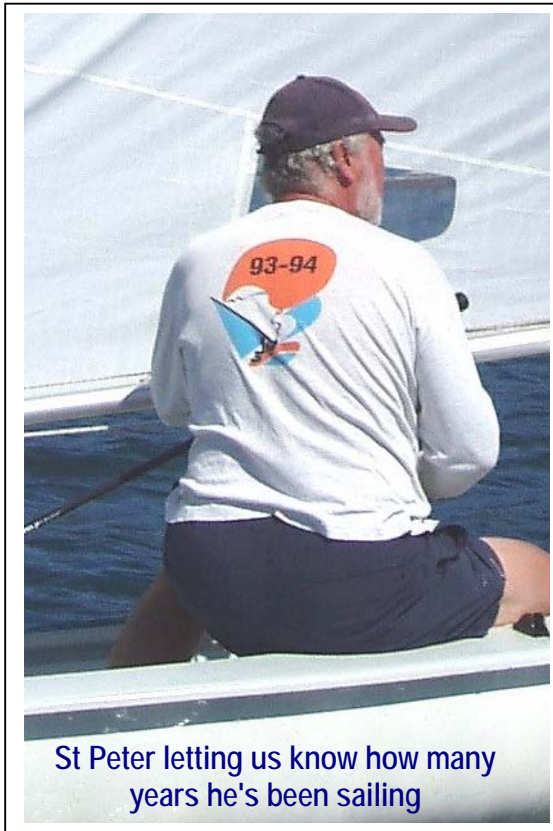
Only THREE more sleeps to go and then you can retire back to your flying.
